Azul Macaubas

Azul Macaubas is a celebrated blue quartzite quarried in the Vereda mountain range near Macaúbas and Boquira in the state of Bahia, Brazil, where it has been extracted since the late 1970s. Its vivid blue comes from the rare mineral dumortierite (around 15% of the stone), and as a quartzite it formed when an ancient quartz-rich sandstone recrystallized under heat and pressure into a stone harder than granite and highly resistant to scratching and etching. The trade name refers directly to the Macaúbas quarry district that produces it. (Some US retail listings label slabs 'Italy' for the finishing/import path, but the geological quarry origin is Bahia, Brazil.)

CARE & INSTALLATION

Clean with warm water and a stone-safe cleaner; wipe spills promptly and use trivets. Sealing needs depend on the selected stone and its use; confirm the care schedule with us. Slab movement and tone vary from swatches. Confirm the actual slab, finish and thickness before fabrication.
